

Horticultural Spraying Specialists Spray guns & lances



Choosing a good spray gun or lance is important – it must be fit for purpose – for what you are intending to use it for.

Below are a couple of options we recommend, having been selling, servicing and recommending them for many years. These guns have all the spare parts and repair kits available which is important to get a good life from your equipment.

Options include:



Left:

Known as the **"Turbo400"** gun, this is an excellent all-round spray gun capable of handling pressure up to 50-bar. Features include:

- ⇒ Ergonomically designed handle to ease wrist tiredness
- ⇒ Protected trigger so it won't accidentally spray if dragged or dropped or break the trigger if it gets snagged. Also protects your hand during use
- ⇒ Swivel connector – vital to avoid fighting against the spray hose and getting tied up in knots
- ⇒ Adjustment lever, on the side of the gun, to change spray angle from a straight stream to a "fog"
- ⇒ Misting "cone" – the orange part on the end of the gun – which when used with the widest spray angle creates a true fog for wetting soft plants
- ⇒ A range of tip sizes is available – standard with a 1.5mm tip
- ⇒ Rugged construction
- ⇒ Lever lock for keeping the gun open, reducing tiredness of the hand when spraying for longer periods



Left:

The **RL10 spray lance** is a high-quality lance for use with 12-volt or motorised pumps where the Turbo400 is too large. It is lightweight and very versatile.

- ⇒ Rated to 20 bar spray pressure
- ⇒ 500mm spray lance, made of stainless steel (note, this can be removed, and the nozzle attached directly to the gun if required)
- ⇒ High quality brass adjustable nozzle to adjust spray pattern
- ⇒ Brass threaded inlet
- ⇒ Trigger lock
- ⇒ Ideal for spot spraying, nurseries & fencelines
