Horticultural Spraying Specialists Pressure gauges



Without a good pressure gauge, well, you're a bit lost. What pressure do we normally spray at? Is our pressure creeping up? Is our pressure too low for some reason? What's the problem with our sprayer?

All operators should be taught what pressure your sprayer should be operating at (a range) so they can keep an eye out if things go wrong. Isometric gauges are very useful – providing a clearer view of different pressure ranges within the one gauge.

Prices range from \$25 to \$76 (plus P&P), so they are a very inexpensive item that could save your bacon!
